The Brains CEDE team (Centre for Educational Stimulation and Development), with an approach geared towards preventative and educational stimulation in early childhood, focuses its interventions on the student's overall development and provides families with support during this process.





SPECIALISMS

PSYCHOLOGY

Talented and gifted students, behavioural problems, attention and memory deficit, social skills, emotional intelligence, counselling for families. Diagnostic reports.

SPEECH THERAPY

Language disorders, articulation, dyslexia, dyscalculia, and dysorthography, reading and/ or writing problems, language delay, problems with chewing and swallowing, voice disorders.

LEARNING SUPPORT

Academic support and reinforcement programmes, study techniques, reading comprehension strategies, learning strategies for literacy and Maths.



MOTOR SKILLS

Psychomotor impairment, body awareness, spatial and temporal awareness, laterality, hypotonia and hypertonia, stimulation in early childhood.

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

Multisensory integration, motor control, writing difficulties, play, peer interaction, autonomy (eating, bathing, dressing).



GROUP WORKSHOP BY SUBJECT AREAS

STUDY TECHNIQUES PROGRAMME

A workshop for learning good organisation and study habits, as well as different techniques based on learning styles. The students will practise skills for writing summaries and outlines, which will enable them to study more effectively.

Recommended from Primary 5 upwards.

The content is differentiated according to the needs of each year group. A specific approach for Baccalaureate students.

One weekly 45-minute online or face-to-face session (peninsular time).

- Starting dates in October and February.
- Times to be confirmed.

Total cost of the course (8 sessions) 190€. Materials are included.

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GROUP WORKSHOP BY SUBJECT AREAS

JENGA PROGRAMME

SOCIAL SKILLS AND EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE

This workshop will focus on different aspects of personal and interpersonal development, peer communication and emotional management, which will enable the students to enjoy their social relationships.

- Group I: from Primary 1 to 3 (Wednesday 17:00 to 18:00)
- Group II: from Primary 4 to 6 (Friday 17:00 to 18:00)
- Cost 82€ / month



A workshop aimed at encouraging students to enjoy reading through lively, fun activities. Our students will also learn to use tools that will enable them to develop their writing in a creative way. For students from **Primary 3** to 3º ESO.

- Grouped according to age.
- Fortnightly workshops in July. 45-minute per six sessions.
- Monday, Tuesday and Thursday: Face-to-face classes (Colegio Brains La Moraleja): 9:15 to 10:00h or online classes: 10:30 to 11:15 h. or 16:15 to 17:00 h (peninsular time). First or second fortnight of July.
- Cost: 110€ / fortnight.

GROUP MOTOR SKILLS

This activity is aimed at students in Infants, as a means of improving their motor skills, their interaction with peers and their autonomy, so that they grow up with properly developed self-esteem.

Timetable: 16:30 to 17:15

- Tweeties: Pre-Nursery and Nursery (Monday).
- Cheeky Monkeys: Nursery and Reception (Tuesday).
- T-Rex: Reception and Preparatory (Thursday).
- Cost: 65€ / month.





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
